





Tsechus (Religious Festival)

Tshechu is the festival-honoring Guru. It depicts a great deed of Guru Padmasambhava, the great Tantric Master who introduced Tantric Buddhism in Bhutan in the 8th century. Mask dances and traditional Bhutanese dances are performed during the Tshechu. The dates and duration of the Tshechu festivals vary from one district to another but they always take place on or around the 10th day of the month according to the Bhutanese calendar. Tshechus are celebrated for several days (usually between three and five).





Trekking in Bhutan

A trek in Bhutan can be anything from a three day leisurely walk around a valley, to the arduous 25 day Snowman trek, taking one well above the snowline into Bhutan's most remote high altitude settled region, Lunana. Trekking will provide a great opportunity to experience and explore real Bhutan.






